• Section 19 of the Indian Penal Code says that the word "Judge" will denote equally to an officially designated judge and to every person who is empowered by law to give, in any legal proceeding, civil, criminal or a definitive judgement. For instance, A collector exercising jurisdiction in a suit as per Act 10 of 1859, is a judge or a panchayat member having power under Regulation VIII of 1816, of the Madras Code, to try and determine suits, can also denote a judge.
