Question

Statement: $Z = J = > L > U > Y$ O W E T Conclusion: I. $T = Y$ II. $Z = U$

Difficulty : Moderate

Average Time : 42 Seconds

Options :

1. Both conclusions I and II are true.
2. Only conclusion I is true.
3. Neither conclusion I nor II is true.
4. Either conclusion I or II is true.
5. Only conclusion II is true.

Solution

The correct answer is **Option 1** i.e. **Neither conclusion I nor II is true**

Statement: $Z = J = > L > U > Y$ O W E T

Conclusion:

I. $T = Y$: **False** ($Y < O < W < E < T$; $T > Y$)

II. $Z = U$: **False** ($Z = J = > L > U$ $Z > U$)

Hence, the correct answer is **Neither conclusion I nor II is true.**
