Direction: In each of these questions the symbols @, &, %, #, and ^ are used with different meanings as follows. You have to decide which of the given conclusion/conclusions follows/follow the given statement. P@Q: P is neither greater nor equal to Q P&Q: P is greater than Q P%Q: P is not smaller than Q P#Q: P is smaller than and equal to Q P^Q: P is neither greater nor smaller than Q

### Question

Statements: J ^ K % L % M, N @ L & O @ P Conclusions: I. P # L II. K & O III. J & O

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**Difficulty : Moderate** 

### **Options** :

- 1. I and II are true
- 2. II and III are true
- 3. I and III are true
- 4. I, II, and III are true
- 5. None is true

### Solution

The correct answer is Option 2 i.e. II and III are true

P@Q: P is neither greater nor equal to Q

P&Q: P is greater than Q

P%Q: P is not smaller than Q

P#Q: P is smaller than and equal to Q

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Average Time : 57 Seconds



P^Q: P is neither greater nor smaller than Q

Statements: J ^ K % L % M, N @ L & O @ P

 $J^K \% L \% M J = K L M$ 

N @ L & O @ P N L > O P

#### **Conclusions:**

I. P # L P L: **False** (L > O P, opposite signs are there between the elements)

II. K & O K > O: True (K L > O K > O)

III. J & O J > O: True (J = K L > O J > O)

Clearly, conclusions II and III are true.

Hence, the correct answer is "II and III are true".

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
