Question

In the following question, the statement is followed by two conclusions. Which of the two conclusions is/are true?

Statement: $M > K > I > J > H = G = F$ Conclusions: I. $H = F$ II. $J > G$

Difficulty : Moderate

Average Time : 35 Seconds

Options :

1. Only conclusion I is true
2. Both conclusions I and II are true
3. Only conclusion II is true
4. Neither conclusion I nor II is true

Solution

The correct answer is **Option 3** i.e. **Only conclusion II is true.**

Statement: $M > K > I > J > H = G = F$

Conclusions:

I. $H = F$: **False** ($H = G = F$ which means $H = F$)

II. $J > G$: **True** ($J > H = G \Rightarrow J > G$)

Hence, the correct answer is **Only conclusion II is true.**
