Direction: Read the given information carefully and answer the following questions. 1 # W = 4 S = D & * 2 7 ! A H 4 % 8 @ ! 5 3 L 9 F @ Q = 6 There are certain operations that are to be applied and then mark your answer accordingly. 1) If each letter in A-Z alphabetical series is represented by numbers 1–26 respectively, then each number in the series is replaced by the alphabet as per its represented number. 2) If each letter in A-Z alphabetical series is represented by number 1–26 respectively, then only the first nine letters of the A-Z alphabetical series is replaced by their represented number and the other letters will remain the same. 3) Symbols '=' and '!' are replaced by a symbol '. Note: - The element once changed cannot be changed thereafter.

Question

How many such numbers are there in the final series which are preceded by a symbol?

Difficulty : Moderate

Options :

1. None
2. One
3. Two
4. Three
5. Four

Solution

The correct answer is **Option 3** i.e. **Two**

Given Series:

1 # W = 4 S = D & * 2 7 ! A H 4 % 8 @ ! 5 3 L 9 F @ Q = 6

After condition 1

A # W = D S = D & * B G ! A H D % H @ ! E C L I F @ Q = F

After condition 2

A # W = D S = 4 & * B G ! 1 8 D % H @ ! E C L I 6 @ Q = F

After condition 3

A # W D S 4 & * B G 1 8 D % H @ E C L I 6 @ Q F

The above series is the final Series.

There are two numbers that are preceded by symbols which are 4 and 1.

Hence, the correct answer is **Two**.
