Puzzle Questions

Direction: Read the given information carefully and answer the following questions. Nine boxes marked as 1 to 9 are placed one above another containing different items viz. Clothes, Papers, Mobiles, Mouses, Pens, Balls, Medicines, Pencils, and Markers but not necessarily in the same order. Only two boxes are kept below Box 7. Three boxes are between the box of Clothes and the box of Balls. Box 7 doesn't contain Balls or Clothes. The box of Balls is kept in one of the places below Box 7. Two boxes are between Box 7 and the box of Mobiles. Two boxes are kept above Box 6. The number of boxes kept between Box 6 and Box 7 is one more than the number of boxes kept between the box of mobiles and the box of Pens. The Box of pens and the box of Papers are not kept at the top. Box 1 contains Papers and Box 9 contains Markers. Box 9 is kept at one of the places below the box of Pens. Five boxes are kept between the Box of Markers and the box of Medicines. Box 6 doesn't contain Mouses. Three boxes are kept between Box 8, which contains Balls, and Box 2. Box 5 doesn't contain Mobiles and mouses. Box 3 doesn't contain Mobiles.

Question

How many boxes are kept between Box 5 and the box of Clothes?

Difficulty: Moderate Average Time: 83 Seconds

Options:

- 1. One
- 2. None
- 3 Two
- 4. Three
- 5. None of these

Solution

The correct answer is **option 3** i.e **Two.**

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Decoding the puzzle

- 1) Only two boxes are kept below Box 7.
- 2) Three boxes are between the box of Clothes and the box of Balls.
- 3) Box 7 doesn't contain Balls or Clothes.
- 4) The box of Balls is kept at one of the places below Box 7.
- 5) Two boxes are between Box 7 and the box of Mobiles.
- 6) Two boxes are kept above Box 6.
- 7) The number of boxes kept between Box 6 and Box 7 is one more than the number of boxes kept between the box of mobiles and box of Pens.
- 8) The Box of pens and the box of Papers are not kept at the top.

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- 9) Box 1 contains Papers and Box 9 contains Markers. Box 9 is kept at one of the places below the box of Pens
- 10) Five boxes are kept between the Box of Markers and the box of Medicines.
- 11) Box 6 doesn't contain Mouses.
- 12) Three boxes are kept between Box 8, which contains Balls, and Box 2.
- 13) Box 5 doesn't contain Mobiles and mouses.
- 14) Box 3 doesn't contain Mobiles.

Boxes	Items

Box 5	Medicines
Box 6	Pencils
Box 4	Mobiles
Box 2	Clothes

Box 8	Balls

Now we have the final arrangement.

Clearly, two Boxes are kept between Box 5 and the box of clothes.

Hence, the correct answer is **Two.**

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
