Puzzle Questions

Directions: Read the instructions carefully and answer the questions. Nine persons J, K, L, M, N, O, P, Q, and R live in 3 different cities Delhi, Kolkata, and Mumbai. At least two and almost four persons can live in the same city but not necessarily in the same order. K lives with M. N lives neither in Delhi nor with K or L. P and R live in the same city but none of them live with L or M. One more person lives with K. O does not live with M. The largest number of people live in Kolkata. L and J live in different cities but none of them live with K. Neither M nor K lives in Delhi.

Question

Who lives in Kolkata with P?

Difficulty : Moderate

Average Time : 61 Seconds

Options :

1. R, N, J
2. L, O, R
3. J, N, R
4. L, O
5. J, L, O

Solution

The correct answer is **option 3** i.e. **J, N, R**

1. K lives with M.
2. L and J live in different cities but none of them live with K.

	Case 1	Case 2	Case 3

City	Persons	Persons	Persons
Delhi	K, M	L/J	L/J
Kolkata	L/J	K, M	L/J
Mumbai	L/J	L/J	K, M

3. N lives neither in Delhi nor with K or L.

4. Neither M nor K lives in Delhi. Therefore, case 1 is eliminated.

	Case 2	Case 3
City	Persons	Persons
Delhi	L	L
Kolkata	K, M	J, N
Mumbai	J, N	K, M

5. P and R live in the same city but none of them live with L or M.

6. One more person lives with K.

7. O does not live with M.

8. The largest number of persons live in Kolkata. Therefore Case 2 is eliminated.

	Case 3
City	Persons
Delhi	L, O
Kolkata	J, N, P, R
Mumbai	K, M, Q

Clearly, J, N, R live with P in Kolkata.

Hence, the correct answer is **J, N, R**.
