Seating Arrangement Questions

Direction: Read the given information carefully and answer the following questions. A certain number of persons are sitting in a single row. Two persons are facing North and the remaining persons are facing South direction. P sits 3rd to the left of R, who is 4th from the right end and faces north. There are three persons sitting between P and Q, who is an immediate neighbor of S. S does not sit on the left of R. A is an immediate neighbor of B and sits 4th from the left end. There are as many persons sitting between B and P as between P and S. C sits 4th to the right of A. There is one person between C and P.

Question

Four of the following five are alike in a certain way based on a group, find the one which does not belong to that group?

Difficulty: Moderate Average Time: 66 Seconds

Options:

- 1. Q
- 2. S
- 3. A
- 4. B
- 5. C

Solution

The correct answer is Option 3 i.e. A

Decoding the puzzle

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- 1. P sits 3rd to the left of R, who is 4th from the right end and faces north.
- 2. There are three persons sitting between P and Q, who is an immediate neighbor of S.
- 3. S does not sit on the left of R.
- 4. A is an immediate neighbor of B and sits 4th from the left end.
- 5. There are as many persons sitting between B and P as between P and S.
- 6. C sits 4th to the right of A.
- 7. There is one person between C and P.



All the persons are facing south except A.

Hence, the correct answer is A.
