The second part is 'A' because it mentions a topic that comes under the radical right upfront.

The third part is 'D' that tells about the other two aspects of censoriousness.

The fourth part is 'B' as it mentions the last aspect of censoriousness and the wider one.

Hence, the correct order is CADB.
