Rearrange these parts of the sentence so as to make it contextually and grammatically correct and mark the correct option. In case of no arrangement, mark the option "No rearrangement required". and are nearly back to pre-crisis levels. (A)/ Not only tractors but rural sales of cement and soap are also doing better than urban sales (B)/ most companies have reported a robust rebound in rural sales. (C)/ with the lockdowns lifting from May onwards, (D).

Options :

1. DBCA
2. DCBA
3. DABC

Solution

The correct answer is option 2 i.e. DCBA.

The first part will be 'D' as it mentions the subject of the topic of discussion.

The second part is 'C' because it mentions the aspect as to what happened with the lifting of lockdown.

The third part is 'B' that tells the departments that have started to do well.

The fourth part is 'A' as it mentions the other part of the sentence i.e. the sectors that have done better are back to pre-crisis levels.

Hence, the correct order is DCBA.
