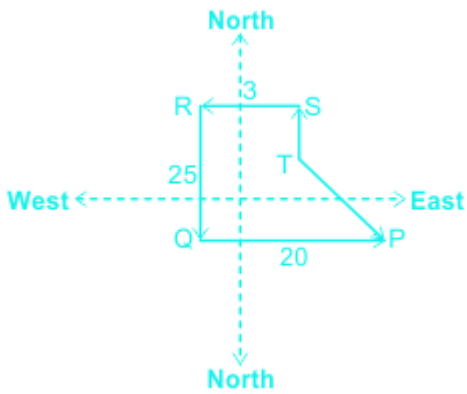
Solution

Understanding

1. A & B means - A is 3 m to the north of B
2. A % B means - A is 25 m to the south of B.
3. A ^ B means - A is 3 m to the west of B.

Friend 2 – P@Q%R^S&T



Hence, the direction of T with respect to P is **Northwest**.
