According to headlines ii. Freedom Fighter iii. Eminent arsonist

Difficulty : Moderate

Options :

- 1. Only i
- 2. Only ii
- 3. All except i
- 4. All except iii
- 5. All except ii

Solution

The correct answer is option 4, i.e. All except iii.

The given sentence can be considered as the headline of a newspaper, thus, (i) is correct.

Moreover, Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose was a Freedom Fighter, thus, (ii) is also relevant to the given context.

As far as (iii) is concerned, Eminent arsonist is not relevant as 'arsonist' is a terrorist and Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose was not a terrorist, thus, (iii) is totally vague and irrelevant with the given context and can be rejected.

As only (i) and (ii) are appropriate starters thus, the correct answer is option 3.
