If the order is already correct then mark the option that indicates 'No error'. Nonetheless, obvious (A), ill-informed and obtuse (B) leaders from more distant lands often needed (C) to have the naive (D) explained to them.

Solution

The correct answer is **option 3** i.e. **A-D.**

The query is about finding words that are contextually incorrect in the given sentence and rearranging them to form a meaningful sentence.

Here in this sentence, it's about 'naive', which means 'without enough experience of life and too ready to believe or trust other people' ill-informed leaders who are from distant lands need *obvious* things explained to them.

So the word 'naive' fits correctly at (A). So, we need to interchange the words at (A) and (D) to make the sentence contextually correct.

The correct sentence is: Nonetheless, <u>naive</u>, <u>ill-informed</u> and obtuse leaders from more distant lands often needed to have the obvious explained to them.

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Hence, the correct answer is **A-D.**
