Question

In the following sentences four sentences are given in bold. They may or may not be in the correct position in the sentence. You have to find out which two or more words should exchange their position so that sentence become grammatically correct and meaningful. If no words need to exchange their position, then mark the option 'No error'. After four weeks of delegates(A)/and discussion the debate(B) failed to agree(C) on a final document(D).

Difficulty : Moderate

Average Time : 45 Seconds

Options :

1. C-D
2. A-B
3. B-C
4. B-D
5. No error

Solution

The correct answer is **option 2** i.e. **A-B**.

- The question suggests finding the correct positioning of words in a sentence.
- In grammatical and contextual reference, A-B seems to be the most logical replacement and should be interchanged.
- '**Delegates**' means a person chosen by a group to represent the group.
- **Debate** seems most relevant after the use of the preposition 'of'.

So the correct sentence is- **After four weeks of debate and discussion the delegates failed to agree on a final document.**
