Question

In the following sentences four sentences are given in bold. They may or may not be in the correct position in the sentence. You have to find out which two or more words should exchange their position so that sentence become grammatically correct and meaningful. If no words need to exchange their position, then mark the option 'No error'. To manage the success(A), some staunch believers consensus(B) the disappointment(C) should not be defined in terms of a claimed outcome(D).

Difficulty : Moderate

Options :

1. A-C, B-D
2. A-D, B-C

Solution

The correct answer is **option 1** i.e. **A-C, B-D**.

The question suggests finding the correct positioning of words in a sentence.

In grammatical and contextual references, A-C and B-D seems to be the most logical replacement.

'**Disappointment**' means the feeling of being disappointed.

'**Consensus**' means agreement among a group of people.

The sentence makes sense only when put in the above arrangement given in the option.

The outcome should be based on consensus, so it is most relevant to the word **consensus**.

So the correct sentence is- **To manage the disappointment, some staunch believers claimed that success should not be defined in terms of a consensus outcome.**
