B- The Ministry has clarified that it's lacunae to hold elephants in captivity without ownership certificates. C- They are sold at elephant markets, from where they are lacunae illegally to other States.

Solution

The correct answer is **Option 1** i.e. **A only**

The question is to find out the correct statement representing the given vocab. We have to find the sentence(s) that are coherent with the word.

Among the given statements, only sentence **A** seems to portray the exact denotation of the provided word.

- The word '**Lacunae**' is plural of lacuna which means an absent part, especially in a book or other piece of writing.
- In sentence **B** '**illegal**' should be used instead of the given word.
- In sentence **C** '**sent**' should be used instead of the given word.

The use of **Lacunae** in sentence **B, C** is **incorrect** as the above meaning doesn't fit in sentences meaningfully.

Hence, the correct answer is **Option 1** i.e. **A only**
