

# Voice Questions Overview

Voice Questions have a good weightage in the Banking Exam and the type of question asked in Banking exam is similar to the question mentioned below. It has been solved and explained by Gargi.ai Experts and they have tried to elaborate the concept used in Voice Questions.

## Question

Choose the most appropriate option to change the voice (active / passive) form of the given sentence. I would advise you not to get on the wrong side of your parents.

Difficulty : Moderate

Average Time : 32 Seconds

Options :

1. It would be advised by me not to get to the wrong side of your parents.
2. It would be my advise not to get to the wrong side of your parents.
3. You would be advised by me not to get to the wrong side of your parents.
4. My advice to you would be not to get on the wrong side of your parents.

## Solution

The correct answer is option 3 i.e. **You would be advised by me not to get to the wrong side of your parents.**

- The sentence is in active form of modal verb.

The structures for active/passive voices are:

- Active: **Subject + Would/should + v1 + object**
- Passive: **Object + Would/should + be + v3+ by + subject**

Going by the above rules, the correct option is 3.

As the chosen option follows the given rule it will be correct.
