Question

Select the option that expresses the given sentence in passive voice. The finance minister will announce the budget.

Difficulty : Moderate Average Time : 29 Seconds

Options:

- 1. The budget will have announced by the finance minister.
- 2. The budget were announced by the finance minister.
- 3. The budget are announced by the finance minister
- 4. The budget will be announced by the finance minister

Solution

The correct answer is option 4 i.e. The budget will be announced by the finance minister.

To convert an active voice sentence into its passive form, follow these rules:

- 1. Identify the subject, verb, and object in the active sentence.
 - Subject: The finance minister
 - o Verb: will announce
 - Object: the budget
- 2. Place the object of the active sentence as the subject of the passive sentence. Passive sentence: The budget will be announced
- 3. Use the appropriate form of the verb "to be" (am, is, are, was, were, will be, has been, have been, had been, etc.) based on the tense of the active sentence. In this case, the active sentence is in the future tense ("will announce"), so we use "will be" in the passive sentence.

Add the past participle of the main verb (announced) after "be" in the passive sentence.

5. Include the agent (the doer of the action) with the preposition "by" in the passive sentence. In this case, "by the finance minister."

Putting it all together, the passive sentence is:

The budget will be announced by the finance minister.
