

# Word Swap Questions Overview

## Question

In the following sentences, five words are given in bold. They may or may not be in the correct position in the sentence. You have to find out which two or more words should exchange their position so that the sentence becomes grammatically correct and meaningful. If no words need to exchange their position, then mark the option 'No error'. The birds were a) chirping early in the morning. The sun was just rising and the morning rays were b) welcoming a new day with new hope and c) aspirations. A boy was sitting near the river bank and d) absorbing all this e) magnificent scenery.

Difficulty : Moderate

Average Time : 53 Seconds

Options :

1. a-b
2. b-d-e
3. a-d, b-c, c-b
4. a-d, c-e
5. No error

## Solution

The correct answer is **option 5 i.e. None of These.**

First, let's see the definition of each emboldened term is given below:

- Chirping: Usually of a small bird when it makes a short, sharp, high-pitched sound.;
- Welcoming: To greet hospitably and with courtesy or cordiality
- Aspirations: A strong desire to achieve something high or great;
- Absorbing: Fully taking one's attention; and
- Magnificent: Extremely beautiful, elaborate, or impressive.

The given statement has no grammatical errors in it. Therefore, option 5 is the correct response.

The grammatically correct sentence shall remain the same i.e.:

The birds were **a) chirping** early in the morning. The sun was just rising and the morning rays were **b) welcoming** a new day with new hope and **c) aspirations**. A boy was sitting near the river bank and **d) absorbing** all this **e) magnificent scenery**.
