

Word Swap Questions Overview

Word Swap Questions have a good weightage in the Banking Exam and the type of question asked in Banking exam is similar to the question mentioned below. It has been solved and explained by Gargi.ai Experts and they have tried to elaborate the concept used in Word Swap Questions.

Question

In the following sentence, five words are given in bold. They may or may not be in the correct position in the sentence. You have to find out which two or more words should exchange their position so that the sentence becomes grammatically correct and meaningful. If no words need to exchange their position, then mark the option 'No error'. The restaurant was well lit. Its a) ambience was b) hooting and there were c) fairy lights everywhere. The crowd in the restaurant were d) spectacular for their favourite team and were ready to e) celebrate its win.

Difficulty : Moderate

Average Time : 51 Seconds

Options :

1. a-b
2. b-d
3. a-e
4. b-c, c-d, d-a
5. No error

Solution

The correct answer is **option 2** i.e. **b-d**.

First, let's see the definition of each emboldened term is given below:

- **Spectacular:** Beautiful in a dramatic and eye-catching way;
- **Hooting:** Shout loudly in merriment;
- **Fairy lights:** Small coloured electric lights used for decoration;
- **Celebrate:** Acknowledge a significant or happy day or event); and
- **Ambience:** The character and atmosphere of a place.

To make the sentence contextually correct, we need to interchange b) with d). The reason behind this interchange is that contextually

the sentence is wrong unless the words from b) and d) are not interchanged.

The sentences here talk about the environment and the energy of the crowd in the restaurant. Therefore, to make this sentence grammatically correct, we have to change the word sequence as given below:

The restaurant was well lit. Its a) **ambience** was b) **spectacular** and there were c) **fairy lights** everywhere. The crowd in the restaurant were d) **hooting** for their favourite team and were ready to e) **celebrate** its win.
