

# Word Swap Questions Overview

Word Swap Questions have a good weightage in the Banking Exam and the type of question asked in Banking exam is similar to the question mentioned below. It has been solved and explained by Gargi.ai Experts and they have tried to elaborate the concept used in Word Swap Questions.

## Question

In the following sentence, five words are given in bold. They may or may not be in the correct position in the sentence. You have to find out which two or more words should exchange their position so that the sentence becomes grammatically correct and meaningful. If no words need to exchange their position, then mark the option 'No error'. It was a a) hustle-bustle day. People were b) hoarding household goods and the snacks were in demand. There was a c) hectic mall. The children were waiting in a huge line to go for d) bowling in the e) arcade.

Difficulty : Moderate

Average Time : 52 Seconds

Options :

1. a-b
2. c-d
3. a-c
4. b-c, c-d, d-a
5. No error

## Solution

The correct answer is **option 3** i.e. **a-c**.

First, let's see the definition of each emboldened term is given below:

- **Hustle Bustle:** Activity in a situation where a lot of things are happening or people are moving around;
- **Hectic:** Full of incessant or frantic activity.;
- **Hoarding:** Practice of collecting or accumulating something;
- **Bowling:** A game in which you roll a heavy ball down a narrow track; and
- **Arcade:** Amusement center which usually has indoor games.

To make the sentence contextually correct, we need to interchange a) with c). The reason behind this interchange is that contextually

the sentence is wrong unless the words from a) and c) are not interchanged.

The sentences here talk about the happenings in a mall and what different people are doing in it.

Therefore, to make this sentence grammatically correct, we have to change the word sequence as given below:

It was a a) **hectic** day. People were b) **hoarding** household goods and the snacks were in demand. There was a c) **hustle-bustle** in the mall. The children were waiting in a huge line to go for d) **bowling** in the e) **arcade**.
